The American Sewing Guild (ASG) is an organization for people who believe sewing is a creative and rewarding activity, people who find sharing the benefits and joys of sewing almost as much fun as sewing itself. The Guild is a network of sewing friends from all levels of sewing experience.

Guild Chapters

ASG is made up of 130 chapters with more than one thousand Neighborhood Groups. Chapters support sewing in their local communities through special events, partnering with local sewing retailers and sponsorship of community-service sewing events. Chapters participate in local community events to expose the community-at-large to the joys of sewing. Chapters provide a wide range of sewing-related activities throughout the year for the benefit of their members.

Neighborhood Groups

At the heart of each chapter are Neighborhood Groups, smaller groups within the larger group that usually meet on a monthly basis at a time and location convenient to the group members. Neighborhood Groups provide an informal opportunity to come together for hands-on sewing activities, presentations, and the perfect setting for sewing friends to share tips and techniques. Future members are given **two** opportunities to visit before you are required to join.

Fort Wayne Chapter

Our chapter is made up of nine neighborhood groups, each with an individual sewing focus giving members an opportunity to learn, share and inspire each other. Our groups meet monthly. Groups include machine embroidery, garment making, quilting and even one that works with Judy Kessinger FitNice master patterns to create stylish fashions! We also have a group for children ages 8 to 18 and groups that gather for general sewing projects. One group meets monthly for a community sewing project making Angel Gowns for local hospitals. And, we provide a variety of sewing-related activities throughout the year for the benefit of our members, including an annual sewing retreat.

ASG National Conference

Each year, ASG hosts an annual conference, the location of which moves each year to another region of the country, providing ASG members from all corners of America (and everywhere in between) an opportunity to experience the fun and excitement of an ASG Conference. Sewing celebrities, educational workshops, exhibit hall shopping, fashion shows, sewing-related tours and leadership training are all components of this very special event.

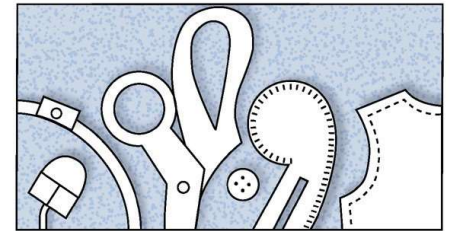
