

## 2021 Ft. Wayne ASG Mystery Quilt Instructions

### # 5 – The Reveal !

Lay out rows 1 – 4

Row 1 - should start with a dark rectangle and end with a light rectangle

Row 2 - should start with a dark square to a light rectangle and end with a dark square

Row 3 – should start with a light rectangle and end with a dark rectangle

Row 4 – should start with a light square to a dark rectangle and end with a light square

Assembly:

Lay row 1 against row 2 – you should have darks together at the top

Pin together at the top – middle – and the end of the strips so that your segment will stay the same length and sew  $\frac{1}{4}$  " seam

Lay row 3 against row 4 – you should have lights together at the top.

Pin together at the top – middle – and the end of the strips so that your segment will stay the same length and sew  $\frac{1}{4}$  " seam

Lay row 2 against row 3 and sew together as above using a  $\frac{1}{4}$  " seam

You now have a segment of 4 rows stitched together. Length should be 70+ inches long.

Sew together the rest of the 7 stacks as outlined above.

Quilt layout will be rows 1 – 4 sewn together to another segment of rows 1 – 4, etc. until all 8 segments are sewn together.

Now it's your choice whether or not to add borders. You should have enough left over fabric to make 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  " borders from each color. There should also be enough fabric to do the binding.

While this pattern has the borders the same width – Jenny suggests making the inner border narrower than the outer border. Again, the choice is up to you.

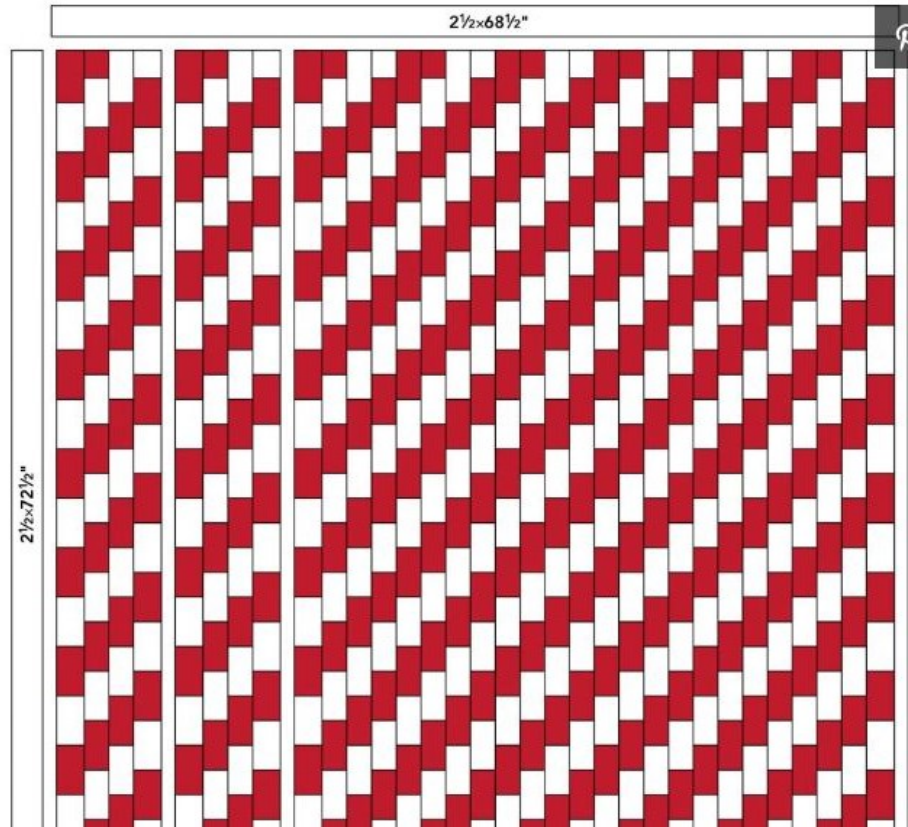
