

# Zippered Undie Travel Bag With Appliquéd Pocket



This makes a great bag to keep all your items together. The appliqué on the pocket is of bra and panties.

## **Material:**

Bag - ½ Yard of 60" wide Heavyweight cotton fabric.

Appliqué, choose a remnant print.

Zipper 18"

## **Cut three pieces of fabric:**

20" X 14 ½" for bag

20" X 17 ½" for back of bag

12" X 12" square for pocket.

Appliqué or embroider design on pocket.

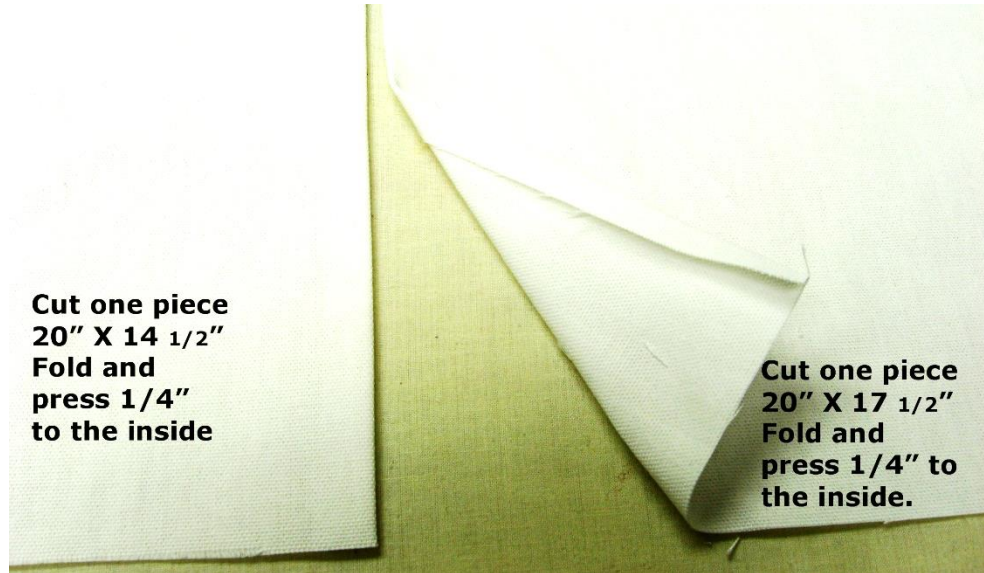
I used black ¼" Quick Bias for ties, but could sew a satin stitch.

Fold and press ½" at the bottom and sides of the pocket.

Fold, press and topstitch 1" at the top of the pocket.

Make a 1" pleat on each side (gives you a little extra room to "stuff"). Glue pocket in place with Fabric Glue Stick and stitch to the smaller (20" X 14 1/2" rectangle for the bag. When you stitch the bottom of the pocket –stitch over the pleats to hold in place.

## To make the zippered bag:





Lay smaller rectangle right sides together with larger rectangle.  
 At the top of the bag, fold the 2 1/2" heading right sides together.  
 Starting at the top of the bag, stitch 1/2" on both sides catching the edge of the zipper.  
 You can stitch through the zipper teeth but you may need to walk your machine in that spot.

Turn and press---fill and travel!

Thanks to Vickie Hall –she digitized this design for me. What a treat—she embroidered and framed my cute cartoon figure. I made a bag the same way except no pocket. I embroidered on the bag itself. This holds all my class notions when I teach.
