

FT WAYNE ASG 2025 MYSTERY QUILT
CLUE 2

Using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance, sew a 2" accent strip to the top and bottom of a 4" background strip. Press the seams toward the accent fabric. Make 4.

Cut each of these strip sets into (21) 2" increments to create a total of 82 "B" units.

Wall Hanging Size
Clue # 2

B Unit

1. Take one 2" background (light) strip and two $1\frac{1}{4}$ " Accent (dark) strips and sew accents to either long side of the light strip.
 - a. You will need 50 of these sets, so depending on how many sub cuts you can get from a width of fabric, you'll need to make a second strip set to get the remaining needed. (I was able to cut 33 from a width of fabric and so cut scrap lengths to 22" to get the remaining 17.)
2. Press seams to the dark side.
3. Align long edge of strip set to line on cutting mat and sub cut every $1\frac{1}{4}$ ". You need 50 "B" Units
