

FT WAYNE ASG 2025 MYSTERY QUILT
CLUE 4

Lay 1 “A” unit and 2 “B” units in 3 rows with the 4” accent strip in the middle. Nest the seams and sew the rows together to complete the block center.

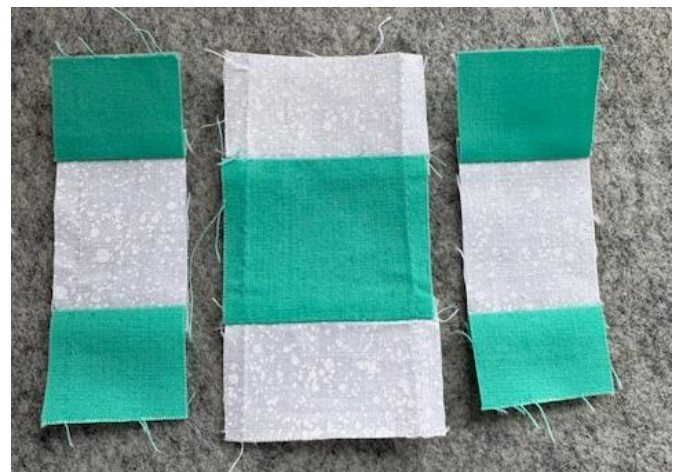
Sew a 7” x 2” background rectangle to either side of the block center. Press the seams toward the outside edges.

Sew a “C” unit to the top and bottom of the center unit nesting the seams as you go.

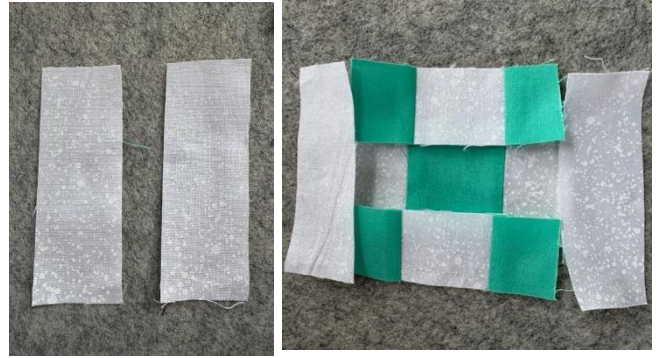
Repeat the previous instructions above to make 41 blocks. Your blocks should measure about 10” unfinished.

Wall Hanging Size
Clue # 4
Seam Allowance ¼”

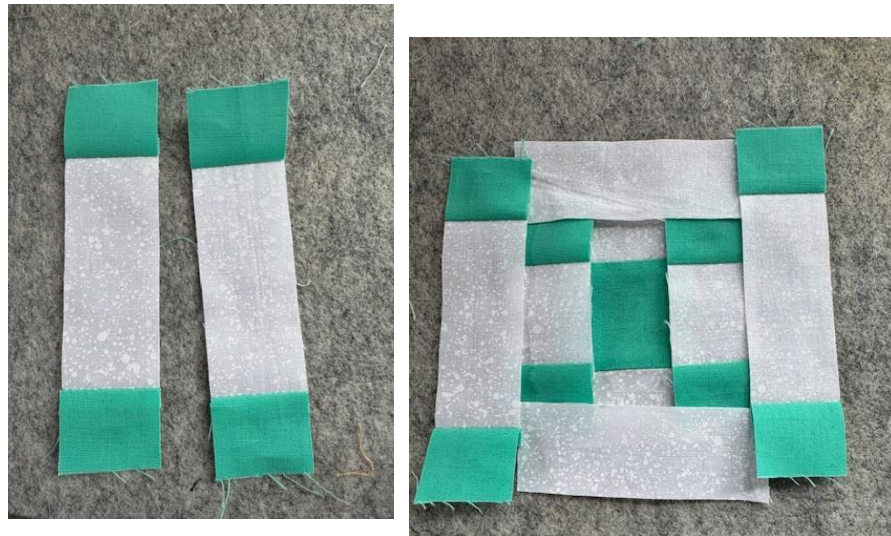
1. Sew a B Unit to either side of an A unit. See photo



2. Take 3 ½" strips of light background fabric and sub cut into 1 ¼" widths. You'll need 50 strips. Sew a rectangle to opposite sides of the block center. See Photos
3. Press seam to the dark side.
4. You will need 25 units



5. Take the "C" Units made in Clue 3 and sew to opposite side of the unit above. See photo



6. The finished block should measure 5" square in order to match your printed 5" charm pack blocks.
