CLUE 6

INNER BORDER

Take the (9) 2 ½" strips you cut for your inner border and sew the strips together end-to-end to make 1 long strip. Cut your inner borders from this strip. Measure your top, bottom and sides for the correct measurements to cut these borders.

OUTER BORDER

Take the (10) 6" strips you cut for your outer border. Sew the strips together end-to-end to make 1 long strip. Cut your outer border from this strip. Measure your top, bottom and sides for the correct measurements to cut these borders.

Quilt and bind!!!

You have just completed the Irish Change Quilt.

***Wall Hanging Size***

**Clue 6 Borders:** Decide the desired finished size of your wall hanging.

More Below:



I cut a 2" inner border and a 3" outer border. The choice is up to you and your remaining fabric.

I cut 4 widths of fabric of both inner and outer border fabrics. I did not miter corners. I attached the sides and then the top and bottom, cutting off excess after attaching.

Sandwich, quilt and bind

**Hanging sleeve option:** I took 4 8" squares, folded on the diagonal and folded again on the diagonal (same as if making a prairie point).

Sew the raw edges of the folded binding to the quilted front side. Then space the long raw edges of the triangles along the top back edge to be encased within the binding seam allowance. Baste triangles to quilt. Fold over the binding and finish sewing by machine or by hand.

The point of each triangle will need to be tacked down by hand to the quilt backing. Once sewn, you just insert a rod and hang! Easy Peasy !
